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## A FREE SERVICE FOR GOVERNMENT AGENCIES

A free Internet tool is now available at <http://cage.rti.org> that compares the costs of switching from one coating system to another. The new process conversion tool helps companies analyze the different costs involved in a coating process, such as material, equipment, energy, and labor costs.

For small or medium-sized businesses that want to evaluate the pros and cons of changing to a new coating type, the process conversion tool is an excellent way to identify what costs may be involved. To start the process conversion tool, users select their current coating system and a new system from over 30 generic coating choices, including one and two-component solvent-borne and water-borne, radiation-curable coatings, powders, electrocoats, and autophoretics. A simple tab system leads the user through the tool to the final page, which calculates total annual costs for comparison of current and new coating systems.

Built-in flexibility lets users personalize their input, so the tool can determine what their annual costs will be. For example, a company may want to understand the underlying costs of switching from a low-solids conventional solvent-borne coating to a powder coating. Using the process conversion tool, the company can enter the costs they are familiar with for their current solvent-borne system and compare them to the default costs provided by the tool for the powder system to determine the cost of switching. The more precise the user input numbers are, the better the model works.

The process conversion tool is easy to use. If a user does not understand one of the required inputs, definitions appear

with one click. In addition, each page of calculations can be printed, so companies can discuss the results in planning meetings. While other cost models leave out equipment costs and nontraditional costs, the process conversion tool addresses equipment costs in detail, as well as other costs such as testing, training, and health and safety costs.

In addition to the process conversion tool, Coating Alternatives Guide (CAGE) offers other tools to help businesses learn about alternative coating systems. An Expert System helps users analyze what coatings may be best for their particular process. The Coatings Alternatives section compiles information on over 30 generic coating types, including solvent-borne, water-reducible, and powder coatings. On-line information is summarized from journals, trade publications, and expert advice. The upcoming Formulations Guide will provide lists of low-emitting paint products. CAGE is an excellent resource for businesses hoping to solve technical and economic issues in the coatings industry.
