IMPORTANT CHANGES FOR ALL LANGUAGE AND ENVIRONMENTAL CUSTOMERS!

Effective immediately, the title to the GSA Multiple Award Schedule for language and interpretation services has been changed from “Translation and Interpretation Language Services (TILS)” to “Language Services”. The scope of services has not changed. It remains as the single most effective contracting vehicle for Federal agencies to procure translation, interpretation and language training from the industry experts. The use of the Language Services Multiple Award Schedule contract can be a valuable tool in meeting agencies need to implement consistent standards of language assistance as established in Executive Order 13166, Improving Access to Services for Persons with “Limited English Proficiency.”



Effective immediately, the title to the GSA Multiple Award Schedule for environmental services has been changed from “Environmental Advisory Services” to “Environmental Services”. The schedule title is changed to reflect the increasingly operational nature of the schedule. The schedule still excludes remediation functions such as clean-up, disposal, or transportation of hazardous waste. The scope of services has changed and now includes,

SIN 899-4 Waste Management Services, *Expansion of non-hazardous recycling services* (the management and operation of recycling programs);

SIN 899-6 Telephone Advisory Services has changed to *Remote Advisory Services*. This title change from “Telephone” to “Remote” is allowing contractors to provide the off-site advisory services via Internet or FAX back service instead of only via telephone; and,

SIN 899-7 Geographic Information Systems (GIS) is a *NEW SIN!* This addition may include, but is not limited to, the following operational services, advice, or guidance in support of agencies environmental programs utilizing GIS: Mapping and cartography, natural resource planning, migration pattern analysis, pollution analysis, site selection, and emergency preparedness planning.
